

## CV DANILO STAGNI

He studied at the Giuseppe Verdi Conservatory in Milan and graduated under the guidance of Maestro Elvio Modonesi. At the age of 16 he was chosen by Claudio Abbado as the first solo horn in the Teatro alla Scala orchestra in Milan, a role he still holds today. In the years 1979-80, always with Abbado, he won the first horn position in the Young Community Orchestra of the European Community, a period in which he was also awarded in various international competitions such as the Viotti (1978) the Verganti of Stresa and the international wind competition of Ancona (1979) as well as various national competitions and reviews.

His solo performances are numerous at the Teatro alla Scala, as well as recordings for Sony Classical and for the radio of Italian-speaking Switzerland.

Since 2000 he has been a lecturer at the Accademia della Scala; has held Masterclasses in Italy and Japan (University of Ashikaga and Sapporo Summer Festival). Since 2008 he has been working as the first horn guest with the Berlin Staatskapelle Orchestra with which he performed the complete Bruckner symphonies and the wagneriano cycle under the direction of Daniel Barenboim.
